Survivors include three daughters, Christina Wesch, Topeka; Linda and Clifford Mills, Chandler, Ariz.; and Katherine and Ron Haug, Buena Vista, Colo.; three stepchildren, Bill and Debra Anderson, Topeka, and Fred Anderson and Melanie Anderson of Oberlin; a sister, Dorothy Avery, Norton; four grandchildren; five step-grandchildren; three great-grandchildren; and three step-great-grandchildren.

She was also preceded in death by her parents; a daughter, Brenda Bryan in 1963; a brother, Huston Hibberts; and a nephew, also Huston Hibberts.

Funeral services were Saturday morning at Pauls Funeral Home in Oberlin. The Rev. Judi Stricker officiated and burial was in the Oberlin Cemetery.
