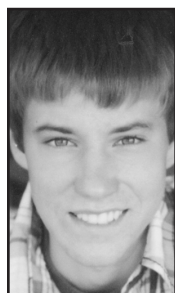


Oberlin seniors to be honored as Kansas Honor Scholars

Windbreak help offered to landowners

The Kansas Forest Service will help rural landowners qualify for money to plant windbreaks, or shelter belts, around their farmstead or headquarters to reduce energy consumption.

Money will be provided through the On-Farm Energy Initiative under the Environmental Quality Incentives Program. Buildings must be heated to qualify.

The application periods for this year end March 30 and June 1. The program is administered by the U.S.

Natural Resources Conservation Service. To apply, schedule an appointment at the county conservation office. Applicants must prepare a tree-planting plan and document the energy savings they expect. "If an interested landowner happens to miss the 2012 deadlines, that is

OK," said Bob Atchison, a rural forester. "NRCS accepts the On-Farm Energy Initiative applications year-around. If (the agency) receives an application after this year's cut-off dates, it will simply be available for next year's funds."
