An Oberlin golfer took first and the Decatur Community High team finished fifth overall at the Ulysses Invitational Golf Tournament on Saturday.

Kade Brown shot a 39 and a 36 for a 75 total score to win.

The home team won the tourna-

ment with 327 strokes, followed by Goodland 340, Meade 357, Colby 359, Oberlin 371, Liberal 377, Lakin 384, Hugoton 394, Ulysses junior varsity 402 and Scott City 429.

## Lady Devils win seventh meet in a row at home

The Decatur Community High girls track team won its seventh straight meet last Tuesday at home in the annual Oberlin Invitational. The boys came in second in a field of 10 teams.

Oberlin's girls scored 144 points to run away from No. 2 Norton, which had 97. They were followed by Smith Center 77, Atwood 61, Dighton 56, Oakley 49, Wheatland 32, Phillipsburg 28 and St. Francis 12.

Smith Center won the boys meet with 97 points, followed by Oberlin 81, Oakley 68.67, Wheatland and Hoxie, 68, Norton 61, St. Francis 56, Phillipsburg 34, Atwood 14.33 and Dighton 10.

Miki Dorshorst, Winter Polivka and Tyler Shields each took two first-place medals. Cassidy Shields, Kiah Blau and Kayla Jones took individual firsts for the girls and Dalton Jones for the boys. Both girls and boys teams won the 4x400-meter and 4x800 relays.
