CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 427 A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING CITY OF JENNINGS, KANSAS

FROM KSA 12-1222 AND PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE AND ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS ON THE SAME SUBJECT, RELATING TO THE CITY LI-BRARY BOARD BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF JENNINGS:

Section 1. The City of Jennings, Kansas, by the powers invested in it by Article 12, Section 5, of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby elects to make inapplicable to it and exempts itself from portions of KSA. 12-1222, which applies to said city but not uniformly to all cities, and provides substitute and additional provisions on the subject as hereinafter provide

Section 2 The City of Jennings hereby exempts itself from a portion of the require ments inKSA. 12-1222 which requires all city library board members to be residents of the city and which provides that library board members can serve for 2 consecutive terms after which they must not hold a position on the library board for 1 year and then are eligible for appointment again to the library

board. Substitute provisions are as follows All members appointed to the library board shall be residents of the municipality, except that 3 members may be residents of Jennings, Pleasant Valley, Allison or Lyon Townships. There shall be no limit on the number of terms each library board member may serve. All provisions of KSA 12-1222 shall con-

tinue to apply to the Jennings library board Section 3 This ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive

weeks in the official city newspaper. Section 4. This is a charter ordinance and shall take effect sixty-one (61) days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for
