Electric rates established

(Published in The Oberlin Herald, Wednesday, September 12, 2012)1t
ORDINANCE # 851
An Ordinance Establishing Electrical Rates.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, that:
Section One. The rate for all electric current supplied by the city during and after the October, 2012 billing that is mailed on or about October 1, 2012, shall be at the rate of \$.128 per kilowatt hour with all customers paying an additional charge of \$7 or \$12 per month for service charge.

Section Two. One-half cent per KWH for all electric current sold by the city shall be dedicated to a street improvement fund from which street improvements shall be paid. One-half cent per KWH for all electric current sold by the city shall be dedicated to an electrical system reserve fund from which electrical system improvements and enhancements shall be paid.

Section Three. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section Four. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
