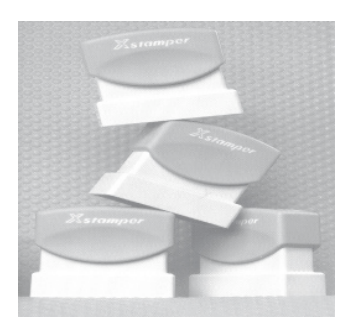

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 855

On December 20, 2012, the governing body of the City of Oberlin, Kansas passed an ordinance entitled: AN ORDINANCE OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, KANSAS, AUTHORIZING THE IMPOSITION OF A ONE AND ONE-HALF PERCENT (1.50%) CITYWIDE GENERAL PURPOSE RETAILERS' SALES TAX AND RELATED MATTERS. The Ordinance approves a 1.50% sales tax on all retail sales in the City commencing on April 1, 2013.
