Spelling Bee. He competed against over 80 other students from all across the state.

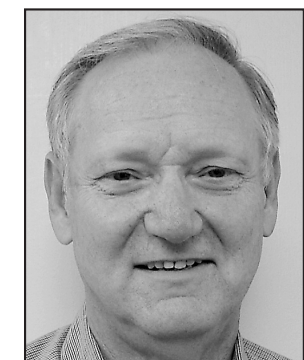
Zeke made it through five rounds and was eliminated in round six on the word "bureaucracy." He placed in the top 20.
