Swimmers take third at league

The Oberlin Swim Club took third place at the Northwest Kansas League meet over the weekend and had a swimmer win the meet trophy.

Jakobi Blau won all her races this season, took the league meet trophy and set a 200-yard freestyle pool record for girls age 13 and 14 in Burlington, Colo.

Darbi Rouse also set a pool record at the meet in 400-yard freestyle for girls 15 through 18.

Keagen Blau won the boys 15 to 18 division with 136 points. He had won all his races up until the league meet but came in second in two there.

Kariah Castle and the girls 13 and 14 200-yard freestyle relay team also took a first.

Other high point winners for the Oberlin team included Jamie Soderlund, 77, second, and Rouse, 57, fifth, girls 15 through 18; Blau, 140, first, and Jenna Long, 69, fourth, girls 13 and 14; Hunter May, 121, second, boys 9 and 10; Bryant Andleman, 71.5, fourth, and Mason Urban, 47.5, sixth, boys 8 and under; and Mollie Tate, 70, fifth, girls 11 and 12.

"I am so proud of these swimmers as we are one of three teams that have less than 30 swimmers competing and still placed third overall at league," said Coach Stephanie Blau. "The swimmers were able to swim in five events in the two-day league meet on Friday and Saturday.'


